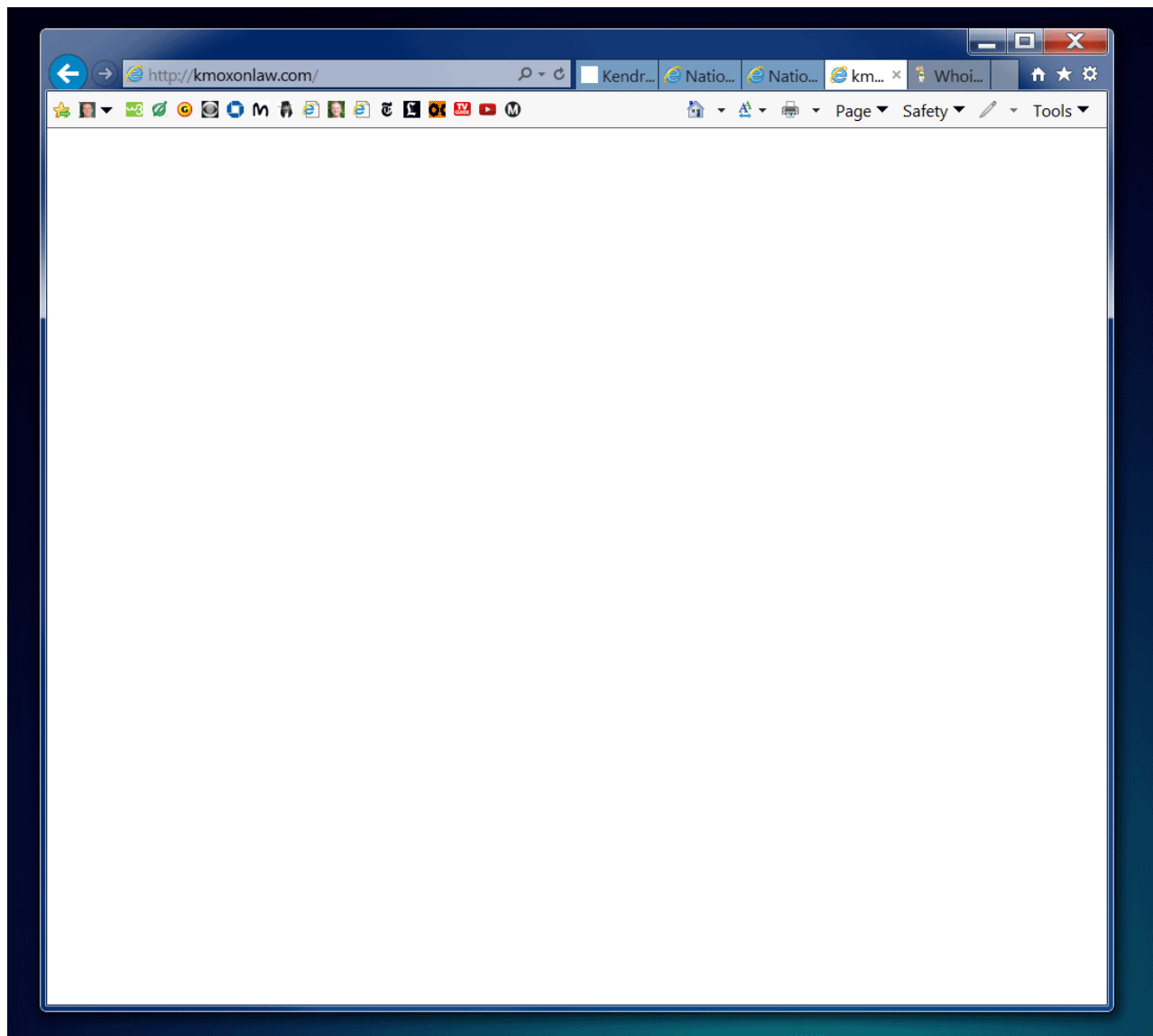

Many people recoil at the words "worst" or "lawyer." Put the two together and what does it mean? Is Kendrick Moxon America's worst lawyer because he always loses cases? No. Although many of his legal filings are intended to harass, not win, he does win cases, sometimes. No, Kendrick Moxon is America's worst lawyer strictly from a human being standpoint. If you think just BEING a lawyer is already as low as you can go in America then you better meet Kendrick Moxon!

As main in house counsel for the Church of Scientology he remained in the cult after his daughter committed suicide. She had been unable to leave Gold Base any other way. His son later fled the cult with his pregnant bride-to-be. She was being pressured to have an abortion as per the policy of their priesthood the Sea Org. The FBI considers him an unindicted co-conspirator in the 1970's era government break-ins of Operation Snow White.

This was the largest infiltration of the US government in it's history and continues today. How Moxon escaped the legal net which caught even cult founder L Ron Hubbard's wife is unknown. But you can bet it was underhanded.

Scientology is sometimes assisted by outside law firms and legal counsel such as Eliot Abelson. That costs lots of money. Rick Moxon, however, works cheap because he is a true believer in Scientology.

2013 A BUSY YEAR FOR MOXON

A lifetime of bad behavior is coming back to haunt Scientology legally in 2013. Just 20 years after their epic battle against the IRS was won the cult is widely regarded to be in a death spiral. The 1993 decision by the IRS to given them tax exemption ended up being their high water mark. But now its members are no longer cowed and protesters continue to pressure them globally. Mr. Moxon finds himself more in-demand than ever as he attempts the impossible task of playing legal wack-a-mole with lawsuits from ex-Scientologists, non-Scientologists and state agencies. 2014 can only be worse.

Their first problem is multiple lawsuits involving their drug treatment center scam Narconon. First there were lawsuits and a raid in their Georgia facility regarding the death of a patient. Those raids led to discovery of multiple incidents of credit card and insurance fraud. Scientology's typical courtroom antics like perjury and faking evidence led to censure by a judge. Narconon GA cut a deal with state and local officials, lost its license and was closed. Meanwhile FOUR deaths at Narconon Arrowhead, their Oklahoma flagship facility, have spawned a class action lawsuit. The Oklahoma legislature passed a law aimed at stopping them. Most people who go to Narconon are not Scientologists and have no idea that they are going to be indoctrinated not cured. The people starting the class action against Narconon have no fear of losing their eternity by attacking the church. With deaths and investigations in Michigan and elsewhere Kendrick Moxon will have his hands full dealing with just this problem, but it is hardly the biggest threat. Meanwhile a Scientologist named Luis Garcia filed a federal lawsuit in January 2013 in Tampa accusing the Church of Scientology of using fraudulent, deceptive and high-pressure practices to coax millions of dollars from its members. In a scam only a Scientologist could fall for, he gave hundreds of thousands of dollars to pay for a never finished building that was supposed to turn him into a superman. This case is significant because, if they win, it will open the floodgates and former Scientologists will rush to sue to get their money back. Lawyers love money, and when they find that Scientology has billions of dollars that belong to their clients they will lose their fear of being "fair gamed" and go at the church with gusto. Most importantly, non-Scientologist Monique Rathbun has sued cult leader David Miscavige for harassment in Texas. Original story here. This case is very important and protester Karen de la Carriere has described it as "The beginning of the end of David Miscavige." They have already caught him perjuring himself in deposition, but that isn't the big deal. The real scare for the cult, and why they sent so many lawyers to this tiny Texas courthouse, is that, if she wins, it will strip away all the false fronts and interlocking fake entities from Miscavige and allow him to be sued directly for the sins of his organization. That's because he is the supreme ruler and nobody in the cult makes a major legal or harassment move without his okay. He micromanages everything, including abuse. And, if she wins, it will show that the cult is still "fair gaming" enemies; something it promised the IRS it would not do. This would almost certainly cause the US government to re-examine it's deal with the cult and put it's tax exempt status as a 501C3 organization in serious jeopardy. The cult has already admitted the harassment in court but claims that this aggressive behavior is part of their religion and protected by free speech! Even more amazing, reporters and ex-cultists who have come to watch the proceedings now say they are being followed just like Monique Rathbun, the plaintiff, says the cult has been doing to her! Kendrick Litchy Moxon holds a B.A. in Anthropology and a Doctorate of Jurisprudence from George Mason University. Before becoming Scientology's lead in-house attorney, he worked in the Church's Guardian's Office (subsequently usurped by the Office of Special Affairs) under Mary Sue Hubbard.

During Operation Snow White, in which eleven Scientologists pleaded guilty or were convicted in federal court, Moxon was listed as an unindicted co-conspirator for providing false handwriting samples to the FBI in response to a Grand Jury subpoena. According to the Phoenix New Times, Moxon has stated that "he didn't knowingly supply false handwriting samples and that the stipulation of evidence was something signed by church officials but written by FBI agents. He says the matter was thoroughly investigated by two bar associations – in D.C. and in California – before they admitted him as an attorney.

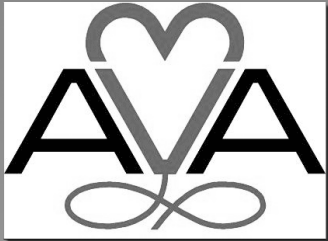

Re: Unauthorized Use of Trademark; Multiple Violations of AUP

Dear Sir or Madam:

Our office represents Mr. Kendrick Moxon, a well known lawyer who has advocated for religious rights for most of his thirty-five year career, particularly the rights of Scientologists to be able to practice their religion without having to be subjected to discrimination, harassment, and threats because of it.

Mr. Moxon owns the intellectual property rights to the name "Kendrick Moxon." He is the only person in the world with this name. And it is with this name that he derives his livelihood and provides goods and services as a lawyer.

We have been notified that one of your customers, ANONYMOUS (who calls himself "Angry Gay Pope"),¹ created a webpage on NTT's website the entirety of which is designed to harass and defame Mr. Moxon, invade his privacy rights concerning the untimely and tragic death of his daughter, and to create hate and discrimination based upon his own personal Scientology religious beliefs. Your customer is also using his NTT services to profit from Mr. Moxon's trademark and trade name, Kendrick Moxon.

These violations can be found under the following URL:

These violations are articulated specifically as follows:

1. Your customer has usurped Mr. Moxon's name, "kendrickmoxon.com" which violates Mr. Moxon's, intellectual property, privacy and publicity rights. He is the only Kendrick Moxon in the world.

The very first thing that pops up on this link is a photograph of your customer in "pope" regalia and in big letters the command to "DONATE" money to him with credit card links to facilitate the donations. This is repeated at the bottom of his website in even bigger, bolder type. Thus, your customer is using our client's trade and service mark as a means to make money for himself and his own causes.

2. The website contains surreptitious photographs of Mr. Moxon, which have been posted without Moxon's permission and thus violate his privacy rights.

3. The statements concerning the death of Mr. Moxon's daughter, who died in an electrical accident in 2000, are astonishingly vulgar, harassing and abusive. For example, your customer has a picture of a body lying dead on the ground with a lightning bolt going into it. Underneath he has written "Daughter Stacy's Suicide." Never mind that she did not commit suicide, the vulgar and objectionable photograph demonstrates the hateful nature of the site.

4. The website contains the following utterly false, libelous, defamatory and offensive statements about Mr. Moxon (which are just a few of such tortious, offensive and libelous statements).

a. As main counsel for the Church of Scientology he defended [the Scientology religion] in the wrongful death lawsuit of his own daughter.

This is a blatant lie and falsehood and therefore defamatory. There was no such lawsuit.

b. He later attempted to have his unborn granddaughter aborted.

This is a blatant lie and falsehood and therefore defamatory.

c. It contains a link which states: "Daughter Stacy's Suicide."

This is likewise a blatant lie and falsehood about his daughter and therefore defamatory. She did not commit suicide.

5. Throughout this website are statements and comments which are hate propaganda aimed at Mr. Moxon because of his religious beliefs and connection to the Scientology religion.

All of these actions on the part of your customer violate NTT's Acceptable Use Policy which expressly prohibits "any activity that infringes or misappropriates the intellectual property rights of others . . . engaging in activity that violates privacy, publicity, or other personal rights of others". "[u]sing NTT America's network as a means to transmit or post defamatory, harassing, abusive, or threatening language."

Accordingly, we request your help in removing this webpage from your service.

Both men allowed their parent organization, NBC, to handle their web prescence much as you have allowed Scientology to handle yours. When they finally decided to get their own websites they found their names had already been bought.

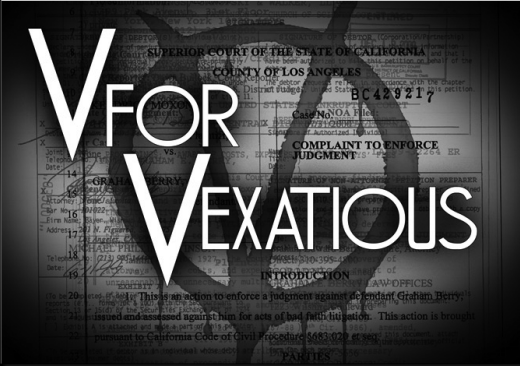

Here is the PM that was found on [Netchan.org](#) in March 2009, where Garry Scarff gives all the details of what Myers had been doing with the donations.

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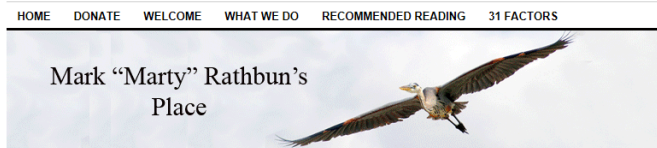

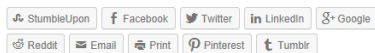
The following two facts have been repeatedly demonstrated and tested – not simply dreamed up and expressed by some authority:

Gold Base (also variously known as **Gold**, **Int Base**, or **Int**) is the international headquarters of the Church of Scientology. It is located in Riverside County, California to the north of San Jacinto and about 100 miles (160 km) from Los Angeles. The heavily guarded compound comprises about 50 buildings surrounded by high fences topped with bladed fences and watched around the clock by patrols, cameras and motion detectors. The property is bisected by a public road, which is closely monitored by the Church with cameras recording passing traffic.

The Church of Scientology acquired the property, which had formerly been a resort called Gilman Hot Springs, in 1973. It had previously been a popular Inland Empire vacation spot and spa established in the 1890s but went bankrupt in the late 1970s due to changes in American vacation habits. Bought for cash in great secrecy by the Church, using the alias of the "Scottish Highland Quietude Club," it has since been developed and expanded considerably. The base now houses numerous Church organizations and subsidiaries, including its in-house media production division, Golden Era Productions, which has its own movie studio on the site. The Church's leader David Miscavige and other senior church officials live and work on the base. It is also the location of a \$10 million mansion built for Scientology founder L. Ron Hubbard. Although he never lived there before his death in 1986, the mansion and his living quarters are still maintained in anticipation of his predicted reincarnation. A number of prominent Scientologists have studied Scientology at Gold Base, notably Tom Cruise.

Up to 1,000 members of the Sea Org, the elite "inner core" of the Church of Scientology, live and work on the base. Conditions are said to be harsh, with staff members paid only \$50 for a 100-hour week and subjected to punishments for failing to meet work quotas. Media reports have stated that around 100 people a year try to escape from the base but most are soon caught and returned by "pursuit teams". Despite many accounts of mistreatment from ex-members, law enforcement investigations and lawsuits against the Church have been thwarted by the First Amendment's guarantees of religious freedom and the Church's ability to rely on "ministerial exemptions" in employment law. The Church denies any mistreatment and calls the base "the ideal setting for professional and spiritual growth".^[1]

Gold Base is located at the base of the San Jacinto Mountains. The base covers an area of 520-acre (2.1 km²) in unincorporated Riverside County, California, outside of San Jacinto, and north of Hemet. It is at or near 1625 Gilman Springs Road, Gilman Hot Springs, California, 92583 and is bisected by a public highway, Gilman Springs Road, just off California State Route 78. It consists of two compounds on either side of the road with underground pedestrian tunnels connecting them. Both parts of the property are surrounded by a chain-link fence topped with "Ultra Barrier" spikes and razor wire, with motion sensors and lights about every 22 feet (8.1 m). There are five heavily guarded gates into the base, three on the south side of Gilman Spring Roads and two on the north.^[2] A Scientology spokesperson, Catherine Fraser, told the Valley Chronicle newspaper that "The spikes on the fences were intended to prevent people and animals from intruding."^[3] When asked why half of the spikes face inwards towards the interior of the compound (as pictured below), Church spokesman Tommy Davis told KESQ-TV that "that's just how they were installed."^[4]

Kendrick Lichty Moxon is a Scientology official and an attorney with the law firm Moxon & Kobrin. He practices in Los Angeles, California, and is a lead counsel for the Church of Scientology. Moxon received a B.A. from American University in 1972, and a J.D. degree from George Mason University in 1981. He was admitted to the Washington, D.C. bar association in 1984, and the State Bar of California in 1987. Moxon's early work for the Church of Scientology involved legal affairs, and he also held the title of "reverend". He worked out of the Scientology intelligence agency known as the Guardian's Office (GO), and was named as an **unindicted co-conspirator after the Federal Bureau of Investigation's investigation into criminal activities by Scientology operatives called "Operation Snow White"**.^{[1][2][3]} An evidence stipulation in the case signed by both parties stated he had provided false handwriting samples to the FBI; Moxon has since said that he did not "knowingly supply" false handwriting samples.^[2]

The bulk of Moxon's legal work is Scientology-related. He has served as Commissioner of the Scientology-affiliated organization Citizens Commission on Human Rights (CCHR). He represented the Church of Scientology in 1988 in a billion-dollar class action lawsuit against the organization by former Scientologists which was dismissed in Los Angeles Superior Court. In 1990 Moxon represented the organization in a suit against the Internal Revenue Service in an attempt to gain access to information about Scientology held by the IRS. He assisted 50 Scientologists in filing separate lawsuits against the organization Cult Awareness Network (CAN), which led to the bankruptcy of the organization. He represented the plaintiff in the Jason Scott case against CAN and cult deprogrammer Rick Ross.

A Scientology publication said Moxon had used church doctrine in bringing down CAN. Its assets were bought in bankruptcy court by a Scientologist and legal associate of Moxon's. Moxon said he was proud of what he had done, referring to the old CAN organization as a "hate group". Moxon represented the manager of the Scientology facility Golden Era Productions in a filing against Keith Henson, a critic of Scientology. Moxon filed an affidavit in 2000 in the case involving the criminal prosecution of the Church of Scientology in the death of Scientologist Lisa McPherson, and defended her treatment by Scientology staffers as part of a religious practice.

Moxon was born in Pennsylvania.^[4] He graduated from American University in 1972 with a B.A. degree in Anthropology.^[5] He received his J.D. degree from George Mason University in 1981.^[5] He was admitted to the bar of Washington, D.C. on September 8, 1984,^[6] and the State Bar of California on June 17, 1987.^{[7][8]}

In 1979, Moxon and Carla Smith had a daughter, Stacy Grove Meyer.^[4] Meyer died on June 25, 2000 after she fell off a ladder and was electrocuted after touching a 7,200-volt wire while working at Golden Era Productions.^{[9][10]} Golden Era Productions was cited by the California Division of Occupational Safety and Health for improper wiring precautions near a vault where Grove Meyer had been working.^[10] The California Occupational Safety and Health Administration investigated the incident,^[11] and determined that her death was not related to the safety violations at the facility.^[14] Grove Meyer had worked for two years at Golden Era Productions in landscaping and maintenance.^{[14][12]}

Guardian's Office [edit]

In 1977, Moxon served as an official of the Church of Scientology, and held the title of "reverend".^[13] His role within the organization in 1977 was called "Director of the Ministry of Legal Affairs of the Founding Church of Scientology".^[14] Along with Scientology founder L. Ron Hubbard and nineteen other Scientologists, Moxon was named as an unindicted co-conspirator after the Federal Bureau of Investigation's investigation into criminal activities by Scientology operatives called "Operation Snow White".^{[1][2][3]} At the time of the indictments and investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the Operation Snow White case, Moxon was working in the church intelligence agency then known as the Guardian's Office (GO).^{[1][2][15]} Operation Snow White was the name coined by Scientology founder L. Ron Hubbard for a mission by the organization's intelligence division to illegally obtain documents from the United States government.^[2] As part of Operation Snow White, members of the Guardian's Office broke into U.S. government offices including those of the Internal Revenue Service, in order to steal documents relating to Scientology.^[2]

A 1979 stipulation of evidence signed by officials for Scientology states that Moxon provided false handwriting samples of GO operative Michael Meisner to the FBI.^{[2][16]} Both parties to the case were in agreement that Moxon responded to an October 14, 1976 subpoena titled "Grand Jury subpoena for all original known handwriting exemplars of Michael Meisner and the employment application and personnel records of Mr. Meisner in the possession of the Church of Scientology" by providing "fake handwriting samples in lieu of Mr. Meisner's true handwriting exemplars" to the United States government.^[16] The stipulation stated Moxon was "directed to supply the government with fake handwriting samples".^[11] Nine Scientologists signed the stipulation as part of a plea bargain.^[11] According to a 1976 letter from the "District of Columbia Security Office" of the Guardian's Office, "Rick Moxon" and four other individuals had either "full data or almost all of it", about covert operations against the United States government.^[17] According to the Guardian's Office letter, Moxon was prevented under penalty of a US\$50,000 fine from disclosing his knowledge of the church cover operations.^[17] The non-disclosure agreement was titled "Covenant of Non-Disclosure; 'Doomsday Agreement'".^[17] The letter told an official for the Church of Scientology to instruct Moxon "if they do talk, then they will be expelled forever, hounded by the GO [Guardian Office] until doomsday, and left to rot in the Physical Universe".^[17]

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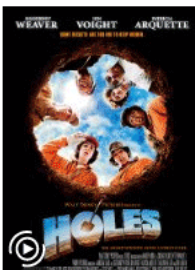

I didn't react much (had to keep my TRs in, you know) but I asked how it happened. Supposedly Moxon and all the other lawyers were working overtime on the IRS case.
